Visit the Weed Warrior booth and get a good start on your garden with the easy "peel 'n pop in the ground" veggie bedding plants for you garden. Weed Warriors offer these plants for donation amounts. They're inexpensive and great quality! All veggie starts are started in organic soil. Various types of kale, lettuces, greens, squashes, onions, choy, cilantro, tomato, etc., and various types of native plants to help pollinators and birds.

Attend the Tree Workshop at 1:00PM. Hear from students how important trees are to us and the planet.

Learn how you can help Newcastle become a Wildlife Habitat Community. Your yard counts toward Newcastle's Community Wildlife Habitat certification with the National Wildlife Federation.
